

New addition to the Ambient Light collection

## More Glow

Iittala launched Glow, a modern take on the traditional oil lamp designed by Swedish architect, **Thomas Sandell**, a year ago as part of its Ambient Light collection. This has now been joined by a new Glow intended for tealights. The original Glow is also now available in metallic grey.



### A smaller Glow

The light from Sandell's original Glow is both beautiful and atmospheric, particularly outside on warm autumn evenings, but many probably find tealights a more natural source of light inside today than an oil lamp. Consumer feedback provided the impetus for Sandell to design a smaller version of the original to give people this option. The new Glow tealight lamp is 115 mm high compared to the 150 mm of the original Glow.

The new Glow, with its signature classic hourglass form, casts a warm pool of light around it, inviting you to take a moment out of time to reflect and relax. Thanks to its smaller size, the new Glow is ideal for creating an atmospheric mood at the table, in bathrooms, or on patios. The simple, low-key colours of the tealight Glow – black, white, and metallic grey – work well with a wide variety of interiors.

"I wanted to create a form that would also be beautiful when the lamp isn't lit. And of course a form that would make the oil lamp and the tealight lamp very much a design for today as well," says Thomas Sandell. "There's nothing more beautiful than a little outside light in the dark, it's like the sunrise over the Baltic."

### New colour option

The upper part of both Glow models is glass, while their lower half is metal. Metallic grey, therefore, makes an ideal new colour option and works very well with a wide range of other colours in the home. The Glow oil lamp will continue to be available in its original colours as well: white, red, sand, and black.
